Lewes-based illustrator Julie Innes runs boutique creative design studio Hollyhock Lane. She has a portfolio of ready-to-print wedding stationery which would fit a variety of themes, and also offers a bespoke service where the only limit is your imagination! Even the ready-to-print stationery can be customised with your names hand-lettered in beautiful calligraphy.

For clients looking for something totally individual, Julie says: "Starting points can be simple like the venue location, the church, the wedding theme and the colour scheme. One of my favourite ever bespoke designs is a concertina panoramic illustration I did of a picturesque Greek island and town where the couple were getting married, with the invitation details and hand-drawn map on the reverse. The design combined a perforated



tear-off reply slip which served as a postcard in its own right."

The whole bespoke process takes around four to six weeks, depending on the scope of the project: as a rough guide a package of 100 bespoke invitations, reply slips and info cards costs around £700. You should expect to pay £175 for personalised invitations from the ready-to-print collection.



BY THE LIGHT OF THE MOON The Hanging Lantern Company, based near Uckfield, has a range of pretty lanterns to suit most themes, from colourful hanging globes to intricately laser-cut birdcage lanterns.
